1 General

The website <https://www.vanreybrouck.be> (hereinafter “Website”) uses cookies and comparable technologies. This cookie statement (hereinafter “Cookie Statement” or “Statement”) aims to inform you as visitor about the use thereof.

The private limited liability company (“*besloten vennootschap*”, abbreviated into “*BV*”) Van Reybrouck (hereinafter “Van Reybrouck”, “we” or “us”) would like to point out to you as visitor that you do not have to accept all cookies. Accepting them is not required to visit the Website. If refused, it is possible that certain of our website applications and additional services will not function optimally (see also Point 5: Disabling cookies and similar technologies).

2 What are cookies?

Cookies are small information files that are stored on your computer or mobile device by your internet browser when you visit a website or when you use a (mobile) application. They function as a kind of reminder for a website. Cookies enable our Website to easily track specific information about our visitors and their surfing behaviour.

Cookies can in principle be placed both by Van Reybrouck itself (“first-party cookies”) and by third parties (“third-party cookies”). Third-party cookies allow certain data to be sent to third parties due to your visit to or use of the Website.

Cookies are sometimes placed temporarily (“session cookies”, which are deleted when you close the browser) and sometimes permanently (“persistent” cookies, which remain until they expire or until you delete them).

3 Personal data and their use

In general, we refer you to our Privacy Statement concerning the collection and processing of your personal data and your rights in this regard.

Since some of the cookies and/or technologies used, which are described below, may contain data that may directly or indirectly identify you, the following are individually explained: the party placing these cookies, the purpose for which they are placed, and for how long the data collected from them is kept.

4 Which cookies does this website use?

4.1 Functional cookies

Functional cookies are necessary for our Website to function properly. The information in question does not contain data specific to the individual user, but does enhance the usefulness of the Website.

4.2 Analytical cookies

Analytical cookies enable us to learn more about how you as visitor interact with and respond to the content of our Website. This allows us to continue to improve our Website design. The information in question does not record data specific to the individual user, but is used to create and analyse web statistics at a global level.

5 Disabling cookies

- Via the Website
- Via the browser

You can choose to disable cookies via the security and privacy settings of your browser. If you continue browsing the Website without changing your browser settings, we assume that you accept the cookies from the Website. In addition, you can also delete cookies by deleting your “browsing history”.

Disabling cookies may result in certain of our Website applications and additional services not functioning optimally.
